

SUGGESTED CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION OF GRADUATES  
OF THE HIGHER AGRICULTURAL INSTITUTES INTO THE  
FACULTY OF AGRICULTURE.

We have received a number of applications from graduates of the Higher Agricultural Institutes for admission into the Faculty of Agriculture. This matter was submitted to the Dean Faculty of Agriculture for consideration with his Faculty Board .

Vide Minute No. 232 of their 120th meeting held on 24th, of April, 1976, the Faculty Board of Agriculture agreed that applicants from the Higher Agricultural Institutes should satisfy the following criteria for admission to the Faculty of Agriculture:-

- (1) Applicants should have preferably obtained the minimum qualifications for entry to the preliminary year in the School of Science (Biological Section.)
- (2) To have passed without any supplementary examination in each of the three years leading to the award of the Diploma.
- (3) Selection from the applicants will be on the basis of competition for the available vacancies as specified in the fifth criterion.
- (4) The successful candidates will be admitted to the second year of Agriculture, so that the candidate takes at least six years to be awarded the B.Sc. (Agric.) instead of the normal five years.
- (5) The maximum number admitted from the Diploma holders depends on the number of vacancies in the second year of the Faculty of Agriculture; after provision has been made for the repeating students, and at the same time the total admitted from the Higher Agricultural Institutes should not exceed 5% of the original intake to the first year in the Faculty of Agriculture (about 13 students.)

The Admission's Committee in its 51st meeting and Vide Minute No. 642 considered the above and made the following amendments:-

Item(1) to read as follows:-

" Applicants should have preferably obtained the minimum qualifications for admission to the University of Khartoum.

Item(4) to read as follows:-

" The successful candidates will be admitted to the second year of Agriculture."
